Dear Parents and Carers,

In today's whole school assembly, I had great pleasure in launching Bredon Hill Academy's first Eisteddfod – a friendly House competition designed to develop and celebrate the creative talents of every single one of our pupils.

The theme for this year is 'planning for the future'. All subjects have created challenges which support the development of a range of transferable skills and underpin the learning pupils have shown in abundance over the course of this academic year. Some challenges can be completed in groups and some tasks have lots of flexibility within their wording so pupils can interpret these in ways which best suit their talents and ideas.

The competition is open from today and runs until Monday 22nd June. Task completion will replace home learning up until this date, though there may be the occasional piece of home learning set by individual staff to support the completion of end of year assessments.

Pupils can complete as many tasks as they like but **all pupils are expected to submit a minimum of three entries before the closing date.**

To support fair judging, pupils have been given an entry number to use instead of their name when submitting their work. **Please ensure all submissions include this number and not their name.** Work can be handed in through email, via the school office or direct to the subject teacher. Each entry earns a house point for your child's House. Any entry which goes above and beyond for effort earns 3 house points. The top entries in each subject area will be rewarded. There will be a special evening for the finalists on Wednesday 8th July, where families will be invited to view the final work and/or performances.

Please take the time to read through the challenges with your child and discuss with them some possible ideas for their responses.

The staff at BHA can't wait to see the creative ideas, designs and submissions of our pupils and we hope to welcome many of you to the Eisteddfod itself on 8th July.
