Dear Parents and Carers

Instrumental Music Lessons at Bredon Hill Academy

I am pleased to share information about instrumental lessons offered at Bredon Hill Academy. These lessons are delivered by specialist instrumental teachers and run alongside your child's music curriculum lesson.

The piano, clarinet, flute and saxophone lessons are invoiced directly by the instrumental teacher termly. The lesson costs are indicated below:

- 20-minute private piano, clarinet, flute or saxophone lesson £16.00 per session
- 20-minute group lesson of 2 (where available) £10.50 per session

All other instruments (cello, drums, guitar, singing, trumpet, ukulele, violin) are taught through Severn Arts. The cost for these lessons is indicated below:

- 20-minute private lesson £16.38 per session
- 20-minute group lesson of 2 (where available) £ 8.19 per session

It is important that your child has an instrument to practise on at home. Please contact Mrs Pilling at BHA for more information about instrument hire if you don't have a musical instrument at home.

If the school is in receipt of pupil premium funding for your child and you would like them to have an instrument lesson, please contact Mrs Pilling directly for more information.

We will do our best to accommodate your request for group lessons, but this will depend on the number, and playing ability, of those who apply. MUSIC TUITION TERMS & CONDITIONS 2026/2027

If you would like your child to take part in music tuition, we would be grateful if you read the terms and conditions below.

1. Payment must be received within one week of the date of the invoice. Non-payment may result in music tuition being withdrawn and if necessary legal proceedings started to recover all monies owed to the school.
2. Payment of lessons led by Severn Arts are to the school through ParentPay. Payment of lessons for piano, clarinet, flute and saxophone are through a direct arrangement with the teacher.
3. To cancel instrument lessons during the academic year 2026-2027, a four-week notice must be given in writing to Mrs Pilling.
4. It is the pupil's responsibility to attend their music lesson on time. All lesson times are displayed on the music noticeboard outside the music room. Pupils must review their time weekly.
5. Pupils must bring their own woodwind, string, brass or guitar instruments to their lesson. Drummers must have their own drumsticks. Instruments can be stored in the practice room on the day of their lesson only.
6. Lessons missed due to pupil illness or family holiday cannot be reimbursed.
7. Lessons missed due to the music teacher's absence will either be made up during the term or will be reimbursed.
8. Lessons missed due to school trips will either be made up during the term or will be reimbursed.
9. Lessons cannot commence until the school has received the signed form stating that the parent/carer agrees to the music tuition terms and conditions.
